

### Application for a Charity Waste Concession with LondonEnergy Ltd.

LondonEnergy operates a concession scheme whereby eligible charities are able to deposit up to 5- tonnes of non-hazardous waste and recyclable materials per calendar year, free of charge.

To be considered eligible for the scheme charities must be able to demonstrate that they are:

- Registered with the Charity Commission
- Based in one of the seven North London Waste Authority boroughs.
   These are; Barnet, Camden, Enfield, Hackney, Haringey, Islington and Waltham Forest.
- Registered as a waste carrier This is a legal requirement, but is usually free of charge
  for charities wishing to transport only their own wastes.

  instructions: https://www.gov.uk/waste-carrier-or-broker-registration.

### In addition, charities must:

- Pre-book deliveries of waste at least 48-hours in advance.
- Take their waste to either the Summers Lane, Hornsey Street or South Access Reuse and Recycling Centres (RRCs) in the London boroughs of Barnet, Islington and Waltham Forest respectively.
- Make deliveries only in cars or in vans less than 3.5 tonnes gross vehicle weight.
- Pre-sort the waste into recyclable fractions and bring it ready for deposit in appropriate recycling containers wherever possible.

Please note that the free charity waste concession operated by LondonEnergy Ltd is discretionary and may be amended, modified or withdrawn at any time.
